

CHILDREN & YOUTH

Nursery care is provided for infants-2 years old and located off the front lobby of the church. A quiet "Mama's Lounge" is available adjacent to the nursery as a place to nurse, feed, or change your little one during the service. Please knock before entering.

All other kids start in worship service with their parents. Preschoolers and Kinders are dismissed each week for King's Kids in Room 8. (Please go with your child to check them in.) First-5th graders attend Faithfinders in the Youth Room on the 2nd and 4th Sundays.

In the back of our worship space there are crayons, markers, paper, and books available for the kiddos each week.

You are also welcome to use our front lobby space if your kids need to stretch their legs and voices a bit more. There are speakers in the lobby that allow you to hear the sermon.
